GRADUATE RECORD EXAM



How much does the GRE cost?	\$205
When is the test offered?	Monday-Friday at 7:45 am or 12:15 pm and Saturday (by appointment only) at 7:45 am.
Do I need to make an appointment?	You can make an appointment by coming into the Computer Based Testing Center and registering with money order or check; or with a debit or credit card register online at www.gre.org to reserve a seat. *Cash is not accepted
How long does the test take?	Appointment times are 4.5 hours.
How long does it take to get my scores?	You will see your unofficial scores for Verbal and Quantitative if you are reporting your scores at the end of the exam. Official scores will be available online and by mail approximately 10-15 days after your exam date.
What do I need to bring to the test?	You must bring your valid driver's license, passport, or government issued photo identification with signature. We provide scratch paper and pencils. *No calculators are allowed. *Student ID is not an accepted form of identification
Is there a study guide?	There is a study guide at www.gre.org , which you can download for free. There is also <i>The Official Guide to the GRE revised General Test</i> for \$35.00
What if I have to reschedule?	You must call 1-866-473-4373 or go online to www.gre.org , 4 full days before your test date and you will be charged a \$50 fee, if it is less than 4 full days, then you will have to repay \$205.
What if I cancel my appointment?	You must call 1-866-473-4373 or go online to www.gre.org no later than 4 full days before your test date, half of the original test fee will be refunded, however, if it is within 4 full days there will be no refund.
How often can I take the GRE?	You can take it once every 21 days, and no more than 5 times in a 12 month period.
