| How much does the GMAT cost? | \$250 |

| When is the test offered? | Monday-Friday at 7:45 AM and no later than 12:30 PM. Saturday at 7:45 am, by appointment only. NO WALK-IN REGISTRATION. |
| Do I need to make an appointment? | You must register with GMAT online at www.mba.com or by phone at-1-800-717-4628 or by fax at-1-952-681-3681 prior to taking the test. |
| How long does the test take? | The maximum time given to take the test is 4 1/2 hours. |
| How long does it take to get my scores back? | You will receive unofficial scores on certain sections on test day. Official scores are mailed to you and to your designated recipient within 20 days after the test. |
| What do I need to bring to the test? | You must bring your driver's license, passport, or a photo ID with signature. We provide you with scratch paper and pencils. *No calculators are allowed. *Student ID is not an accepted form of identification |
| Is there a study guide? | Yes, the GMAT Prep test preparation software is located at www.mba.com/gmatprep , which you can download for free. |
| What if I have to reschedule? | You must go online to www.mba.com , 7 full days before your test date and you will be charged a \$50 fee, if it is within the 7 full days, then you will have to repay the full amount of \$250. |
| What if I cancel my appointment? | If you cancel your registration no later than 7 full days before your test date, you will be refunded, \$80, if it is within 7 full days there will be no refund. |
| Do I get my results the same day? | You will receive your unofficial analytical and verbal scores at the end of your test. You must wait 15 business days from the day of your test and you can retrieve your scores at www.ets.org . |
| How often can I take the GMAT? | You can take it once every 16 calendar days, but no more than a 12 month period. |
