How much does the LSAT cost?	\$215
When is the test offered?	The available test dates can be found online at <a href="http://www.LSAC.org">www.LSAC.org</a>
Do I need to make an appointment?	Yes. Make an appointment online at <a href="http://www.lsat.org">www.lsat.org</a> to reserve a seat.
How long is the test?	There are 3.5 hours allotted for the LSAT. Test consists of three 35-minute sections (Reading Comprehension, Analytical Reasoning, and Logical Reasoning) of multiple-choice questions, one unscored 35-minute section, and a 35-minute writing section for testers without a writing sample on file. There is a 10-minute break scheduled between the second and third sections.
How long does it take to get my scores back?	LSAT takers who have <a href="http://LSAC.org">LSAC.org accounts</a> will automatically receive their LSAT scores by e-mail approximately three weeks after taking the test. If you do not have an LSAC account, your scores will be mailed in approximately four weeks.
What do I need to bring to the test?	LSAT tests are currently only being offered remotely—LSAT Flex. For more information visit <a href="https://www.lsat.org/update-coronavirus-and-lsat/lsat-flex">https://www.lsat.org/update-coronavirus-and-lsat/lsat-flex</a>
Is there a study guide?	Yes, free study guides can be downloaded at <a href="http://www.LSAC.org">www.LSAC.org</a>
What if I have to reschedule?	If you are unable to take the LSAT on the date for which you are registered, you may request a change to another test date <b>free of charge</b> by logging onto your <a href="http://LSAC.org">LSAC.org</a> account <b>if the test date change deadline has not passed</b> . There is a <b>\$135 fee up to 10 days after your administration's registration</b> deadline and your request must meet the designated test date change deadlines available online. <b>Eleven days after your administration's registration deadline will result in a \$215 fee.</b>
What if I need to cancel my appointment?	Upon written request, LSAC will cancel your appointment. You will be fully refunded if the written request is received by the refund deadline available online at <a href="http://www.lsat.org/jd/lsat/lsat-cas-refunds">www.lsat.org/jd/lsat/lsat-cas-refunds</a> . After the full refund deadline, you can request a partial refund of \$50 through the partial refund deadline.
Can I cancel my scores?	You will be provided the option after completing your examination to cancel your score. If you wish to cancel scores after you have taken your test you can do so by logging onto your <a href="http://LSAC.org">LSAC.org</a> account and going to the LSAT Status page. The request <b>must be received</b> to LSAC <b>within six calendar days</b> of the test.
How often can I take the LSAT?	You may not take the LSAT more than <b>3 times within a single testing year.</b>
