How much does the LSAT cost?	\$180 (+\$90 for late registration)
When is the test offered?	The available test dates can be found online at <u>www.LSAC.org</u>
Do I need to make an appointment?	Yes, no walk-in allowed. Make an appointment online at <u>www.lsac.org</u> to reserve a seat.
How long is the test?	There are 3.5 hours allotted for the LSAT. Test consists of five 35-minute sections (Reading Comprehension, Analytical Reasoning, and Logical Reasoning) of multiple choice questions and a 35-minute writing section.
How long does it take to get my scores back?	LSAT takers who have <u>LSAC.org accounts</u> will automatically receive their LSAT scores by e-mail approximately three weeks after taking the test. If you do not have an LSAC account, your scores will be mailed in approximately four weeks.
What do I need to bring to the test?	Bring your valid driver's license (first & last name must match registration), passport or government issued photo ID with signature, your admission ticket, and four sharpened No. 2 or HB wooden pencils. Other permitted items may be found at <u>http://lsac.org/jd/lsat/day-of-test</u> . *Student ID is not an accepted form of identification
Is there a study guide?	Yes, free study guides can be downloaded at <u>www.LSAC.org</u>
What if I have to reschedule?	If you are unable to take the LSAT on the date for which you are registered, you may request a change to another test date by logging onto your <u>LSAC.org</u> Account if the test date change deadline has not passed. Your request must meet the designated test date change deadlines available online.
What if I need to cancel my appointment?	Upon written request, LSAC will cancel your appointment. You will be refunded \$49 if the written request is received by the refund deadline available online at www.lsac.org/jd/lsat/lsat-cas-refunds
Can I cancel my scores?	Your answer sheet will contain a section allowing you to cancel your score. If you wish to cancel scores after you have taken your test you can do so by logging onto your <u>LSAC.org</u> Account and going to the LSAT Status page. The request must be received to LSAC within six calendar days of the test.
How often can I take the LSAT?	You may not take the LSAT more than 3 times in any two year period.
