

PRAXIS SUBJECT ASSESSMENTS INFORMATION



How much does the PRAXIS II cost?	Praxis subject assessment fees vary depending on exam subject needed. See fee schedule at www.ets.org/praxis .
When is the test offered?	Individual sections are available Monday–Friday starting at 8:00 a.m., with the latest start time at 1:30 p.m. Please see www.ets.org/praxis for specific testing windows.
Do I need to make an appointment?	An appointment must be scheduled via the Praxis website at http://www.ets.org/praxis or by calling 1-800-772-9476 (if you already have a praxis account).
How long is the test?	Testing times vary by exam but appointment times are 2-4 hours depending on the subject exam. Appointment times include time for check-in and check-out. Please visit www.ets.org/praxis for more information regarding your specific exam.
How long does it take to get my scores back?	Your official scores are available to you via your online account. Official score reporting dates vary, depending on which test you took. Please see the Getting Your Praxis Scores (https://praxis.ets.org/test-taker/getting-scores.html) for additional information on the score reporting dates. When your scores are available, you will receive an email notifying you that your score report is ready to view online.
What do I need to bring to the test?	Bring your valid driver's license, passport or government issued photo ID with signature- original documents only (no copies or digital documents). The name on your ID must exactly match the name you registered with. We provide scratch paper and pencils. A calculator is provided within the test software for most exams. Check the praxis website for your exam to determine if a physical calculator is allowed. *Student ID is not an accepted form of identification*

What if I have to reschedule?	Call 1-800-772-9476 or go online at www.ets.org/praxis 3 full days ahead of your test date and you will be charged a \$40 fee per test session. If it is less than 3 full days, then you will have to repay the full amount.
What if I have to cancel my appointment?	Call 1-800-772-9476 or go online to www.ets.org/praxis no later than 3 full days before your test date. If you cancel your test by the appropriate deadline, you may be eligible for a refund of 50 percent of your test fees.
How often can I take the Praxis II?	Tests offered continuously may be taken once every 28 days, not including your initial test date. Tests offered during testing windows may be taken once per testing window. This applies even if you canceled your scores on a test taken previously. If you violate this restriction, the scores from your retest will not be reported and your test fees will not be refunded.
